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### Course Description:

Geometry is a required one credit (full year) course. This course teaches students the knowledge and skills necessary for passing the new state test for gaining high school credit and for use on the Michigan Merit Exam. A variety of materials, methods, projects, and activities will be used in class to assist students in demonstrating the necessary proficiency on unit tests in order to earn semester credit.
